

HOW TO GET HERE



Please use public transport where possible.

BY BUS: Regular bus services run from the city centre along the Banbury Road. Cutteslowe Park is a short walk from the Five Mile Drive bus stop.

PARK & RIDE: The nearest Park & Ride is Oxford Parkway. Buses stop at the top of Harbord Road, which is a 10 minute walk to the park.

BY CAR: For the Woodland Trail use the Cutteslowe Car Park – OX2 8NP (for Sunnymead, use OX2 7XD). Please note, parking charges apply at both car parks. Parking restrictions apply to surrounding residential roads throughout the week.

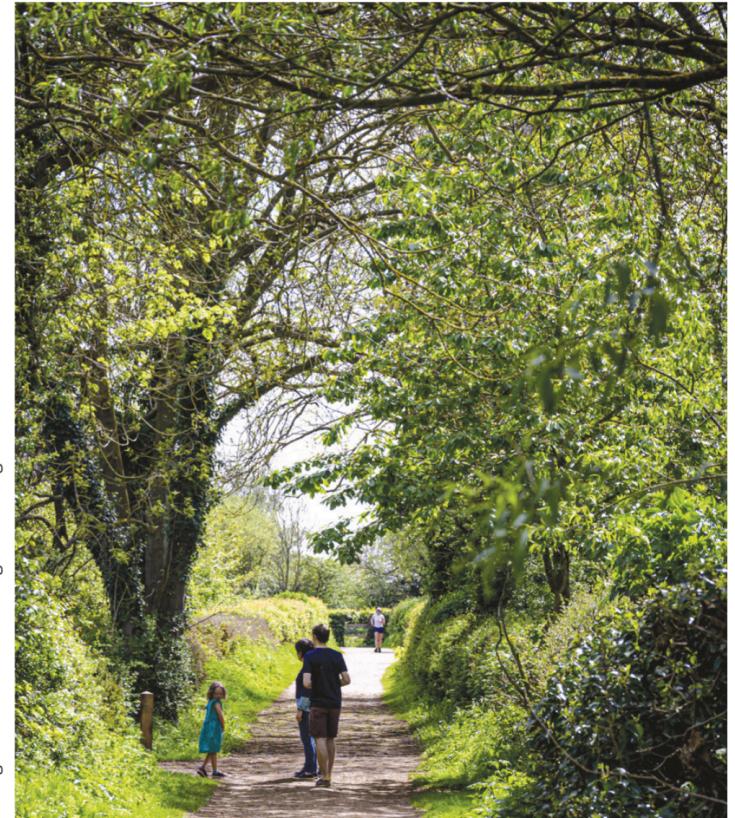
